Bohol

This province of the Philippines is located in the heart of the Visayas in the center of the country. The capital city is Tagbilaran. It is the 10th largest island of the country. Bohol is a popular tourist destination with its magnificent beaches and natural scenery. The chocolate hills, limestone mounds that change colour with the seasons are a main attraction. The climate is generally dry with maximum rainfall between June and October.

Cebu

Cebu is a long and narrow island stretching 225 Km from north to south and surrounded by 167 other islands. It is one of the most developed islands in the country and is a key business center for the various industries in the country. There are many 5* hotels, casinos, white sand beaches, golf courses and shopping areas.

Boracay

Boracay is a perfect island with warm blue waters, fine white sand and 4 Km of beaches. This world renowned island is in Aklan Province, 345 Km south of Manila. It can be reached by plane from Manila or Cebu via two major airports : Catidan or Kalibo.

Palawan

Southwest of Manila, lies the island of Palawan which extends almost to Borneo. It is the largest national park in the Philippines where islands, beaches and reefs stretch to infinity, especially in the northern part of the island. Islets and islands constitute a jungle covered maze in exceptionally transparent waters. Puerto Princesa is the major city and airport access, located in the center of Palawan. The region is made up of characteristic limestone cliffs, whose weird shapes have been carved by centuries of erosion.
